01. Hoisting the National Flag
02. Singing the National Anthem
03. Observing two-minute silence in memory of National Heroes who sacrificed their lives for the country

06. Reading the messages of His Excellency the President, Hon. Prime Minister and the Hon. Minister of Foreign Relations
07. Address of the Consul General
